

IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO APPLICANTS CONCERNING THE RUTH G. MILLS SCHOLARSHIP FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION

In 1988 this scholarship award was established through the generosity of the late Ruth G. Mills (a 1932 graduate of Sodus Central) to assist graduates who are continuing their education at 4 year colleges.

The amount of the award is determined each year from the available income divided among the qualified applicants. The number and the amount of the award will be at the discretion of the Sodus Central School Scholarship Fund, Inc.

Eligibility criteria for the Mills Continuing Award:

The applicant must be - a graduate of SCS with at least 2 years of attendance including the senior year - a full-time undergraduate student currently enrolled in a four year college (full time is 12 credit hours or higher)

The applicant must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average as of February 1 of the current year. Applicants are eligible for no more than 3 Mills awards within six years of high school graduation.

In order to receive the scholarship award you must file the following paperwork by the given deadlines. All payments are made after October 1st .

1. Application (found on SCS guidance website or in your award letter) by April 15th
2. "Letter of Intent" (Deadline September 1st)
3. "Request for Payment" and "proof of enrollment" (a money owed bill or paid receipt from the college) to HSBC bank (deadline October 1st)

The Mills award is presented at the Senior High Awards Assembly in June. (See the school calendar for the date and call the High School to confirm.)

All of the awards are given at the discretion of the Board of Trustees of the Sodus Central School Scholarship Fund, Inc.
