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**NOTICE OF ANNUAL BUDGET VOTE, BUDGET HEARING, AND ELECTION OF TRUSTEES  
To the qualified voters of Sodus Central School District:**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to the Education Law of the State of New York, that a public hearing of the qualified voters of the Sodus Central School District will be held virtually on Wednesday, May 27 at 7:00 PM, for the presentation of the budget. Information regarding the budget hearing may be accessed on the District's website at <https://www.soduscsc.org>;

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the annual meeting of the qualified voters of the Sodus Central School District will be held on Tuesday, June 9, 2020 via absentee ballot to vote upon the annual budget for the 2020-2021 academic year, the election of four (4) members of the Board of Education, and the following propositions:

PROPOSITION 1: Shall the proposed School Budget for the period July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 be approved?

PROPOSITION 2: Shall the Board of Education be authorized to expend from the Bus Purchase Reserve Fund an amount not to exceed \$350,000 in the 2020-2021 fiscal year for the purpose of purchasing buses for student transportation?; and

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following vacancies on the Board of Education are to be filled:

- One 3-year term, commencing July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2023, to fill the seat currently held by Laura Steffler-Alampi;
- One 3-year term, commencing July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2023, to fill the seat currently held by Tracy Sergeant;
- One 1-year, 20-day term, commencing July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021, to fill the seat currently held by Tony Cincinello;
- One 1-year, 20-day term, commencing July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021, to fill the seat currently held by Sarah Williams; and

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a detailed statement in writing of the amount of money which will be required for the ensuing year, July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, for school purposes, specifying the several purposes, and the amount for each, may be obtained by any resident of the District during the fourteen (14) days immediately preceding the annual meeting, and on the date of the election, at the District Office, 6375 Robinson Road, Sodus, New York, or at the Main Office of each school during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 Noon, and 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. on each day other than Saturday, Sunday, or a holiday, and at said meeting of the District;

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, in accordance with Executive Order 202.26, at least one (1) absentee ballot shall be provided per registered voter for the 2020 annual meeting. If a household requires additional ballots, please contact the District Clerk at (315) 483-2331 or [RMoline@soduscsc.org](mailto:RMoline@soduscsc.org). A list of persons to whom absentee ballots have been issued will be available for inspection in the office of the District Clerk during regular business hours, during each of the five (5) days prior to the election, except Sundays, and shall also be posted at the door of the polling place(s) on June 9, 2020. Absentee ballots must be **received** by the District Clerk by 5:00 p.m. on June 9, 2020.; and

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that military voters who are qualified voters of the District may apply for a military ballot by requesting an application from the District Clerk at 315-483-5201 or [rmoline@soduscsc.org](mailto:rmoline@soduscsc.org). For a military voter to be issued a military ballot, the District Clerk must have received a valid ballot application no later than 5:00 pm on May 14, 2020. In a request for a military ballot application or ballot, the military voter may indicate their preference for receiving the application or ballot by mail, facsimile transmission, or electronic mail.
